Purpose of role	ABCs Free Shop aims to provide a choice of free clothing, shoes and household items. and dignity to in need refugees and those seeking asylum in Bristol. Sometimes donations need to be collected from a donors house or delivered to a service user in need. Additionally, sometimes inappropriate, or surplus donations need to be transported elsewhere.
